THIRD ANNUAL CITIZEN SOLDIER AWARD 2023 NOMINATION FORM

OVERVIEW OF AWARD:

The Citizen Soldier Award, established in 2020, stands to honor a person who exemplifies the traditions of the citizen soldier set by George Washington; a person who served the nation as a leader in war and in peace, for the betterment of the common good. Past recipients include the late Senator Bob Dole, RADM Richard W. Schneider, GEN Ann Dunwoody, COL Jack Jacobs, LTC Enoch O.D. "Woody" Woodhouse II and the late CWO4 Hershel "Woody" Williams.

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

- ☆ An individual (living or deceased) who has lived the mission of the citizen soldier;
- ☆ Individual must have served or is currently serving in the US Armed Forces, guard or reserves, and either general or honorable discharge. Does not need to be a US citizen;
- ☆ Individual must be nationally recognized; international recognition is highly desirable;
- ☆ Service commensurate with the values and ideals of the citizen soldier as exemplified by George;
- ☆ Washington whether as a "soldier" or a "citizen", serving as a leader in both military and civilian arenas;
- ☆ Commitment to non-partisan issues and the ability to bridge political divides, demonstrating a benefit to society;

NOTABLE DATES:

- ☆ **March 21, 2023 - April 14, 2023:** PMML Members may nominate one individual (self-nominations are not allowed) for the award.
- ☆ **May 23, 2023:** Recipient of the 2023 Citizen Soldier Award will be announced after review of all nominations by a committee of PMML Board Members, PMML Founder, previous award winners or their designates/family, and other notable veterans.
- ☆ **November 4, 2023:** Recipient of the 2023 Citizen Soldier Award will receive the award at the 20th Annual PMML Liberty Gala.
