### **Scope and Content of the Collection**

The Ephemera from the Jo Ann Joyce Book Collection consists of newspaper and magazine clippings, cards and letters, photographs and other ephemeral material from the 1960s to 1980s. In 2010, Ms. Joyce donated 299 books to the Pritzker Military Museum and Library and the items were found during processing. Many of the items belonged to Thomas Joyce.

#### **Arrangement**

The collection arrived with no discernable arrangement and was rearranged by subject matter and chronologically in a more efficient working order by PMML staff. The collection is contained within 6 archival folders.
