Scope and Content of the Collection

The Ephemera from the Joyce Family Book Collection consists of items separated from a collection of 514 military-related books donated to the Pritzker Military Library by the Joyce family of Chicago, IL. Items include magazine and newspaper clippings relating to American Prisoners of War and other global military events of the 1960s and 1970s, photographs and other ephemeral material.

Arrangement

The collection arrived with no discernable arrangement and was rearranged by subject matter and chronologically in a more efficient working order by PMML staff. The collection is contained within 1 archival folder. Photographs and artifacts have been separated from the archival material.
