Biographical Note

Major John Edward McGovern, Sr. was born on July 9, 1895, to parents Michael J. and Bridget McGovern. McGovern enlisted in August 1917, and served as part of the Aviation Section, U.S. Signal Corps until January 1919.

During World War II, he reentered the service with the U.S. Army Air Force in April 1942. He arrived in the European Theater in June 1942 and worked with various squadrons as an S-2 Intelligence Officer. During his service, several squadrons he worked with operated with the Royal Air Force (RAF). McGovern reverted to inactive duty on May 22, 1944.

Based off the Air Force Reserve Qualification Data document (Item #: 800342424) in the collection, McGovern's service with the Air Force Reserved appears to have ended in April 1953.

Scope and Content of the Collection

This collection contains correspondence, military documents, personnel files, reports brochures, and ephemera from McGovern's service in World War I and World War II. The materials in this collection span from 1917 to 1952.

Arrangement

PMML staff has imposed order to some series of this collections, other series remain in original order.

Series One: World War I (1917-1929, u.d.)

Series one contains materials related to McGovern's service during World War I and some post-service veteran's documents. This series is arranged by document type.

Series Two: World War II (1931-1948, u.d.)

Series two contains materials from McGovern's service in World War I. This collection arrived organized within several folders and the original order has been maintained.

Series Three: 201 Personnel Files (1918-1952, u.d.)

Series three contains McGovern's military personnel file (also known as 201 file). This collection maintains the original order the documents arrived in.
